2	Be under the age of 40 as of 1 st April 2016
3	Bachelor's Degree in any field (Diploma is not accepted)
4	[Applicant from Public Sector/ Education institution (lecturer)] At least 6 months working experience at current organization / permission from your organization to apply
5	Clear understanding of the programme objective, and strong will to contribute to Africa's industrial development
6	Not involved in military-related activities
