GUIDELINES FOR REPORTING BACK ON YOUR EXCHANGE EXPERIENCE:

You need to submit a report, blog and picture poster to IAPO during and on return from your exchange. These are important tools that will help prospective students learn about the different exchange opportunities available to them.

The picture poster must be laminated and can be A2 in size. Please include your name, host institution, semester and year as well as captions for your photos. You are most welcome to decide how you want to arrange your photos.

The report should focus on the following topics: academics, accommodation, finances, culture shock and tips for the next group of students that go to your host institution. The more detail you go into, the better it would read for someone with no idea what an exchange is about. For example, think about what you would have wanted to know regarding the different options for housing, or what the classroom dynamics and assessment formats are like. There is no word limit. The information in your blog may be similar to that in your report.
